## 1<sup>st</sup> registered JI methodology for the professional fishing sector

- **ecosur** is pleased to announce the development and successful registration of the 1<sup>st</sup> JI methodology developed and registered for the professional fishing sector (DR-METH-0016 methodology).
- The methodology has been developed by **ecosur** on behalf of the French Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Fishing Industry Adaptation Fund (FPAP). The technical work has been assessed by the French Ministry of Environment and the French Ministry of Finance and Industry. Following the recommendations of the Ministry, the French Designated National Authority under the Kyoto Protocol registered the methodology the 29<sup>th</sup> of July.
- DR-METH-0016 methodology is the 6<sup>th</sup> JI methodology to be registered in France and the first ever for the fishing sector worldwide.
- FPAP stands for Fonds de Prévention des Aléas de la Pêche. The Fund has been set up by the government to regulate gasoil prices and its impacts on the French professional fishing sector.
